The United States vision for the post-war world was for an era of peaceful cooperation and recovery with security ensured by the four policemen : the United States, Great Britain, the Soviet Union, and China. This desired stability would be accomplished by a strategy of containment by inclusion or integration, bringing the Soviet Union fully and equally into the normal commu-nity of nations. This would be accomplished largely through economic assistance and diplomacy. But Soviet intransigence at every turn led the United States to search for an alternative implementation strategy,...
