The Fifth Annual Conference of the Alabama Home Economics Association met at Montevallo January 30-31, 1920. This was the first meeting since 1918. In the absence of Miss Sarah Bandy, President of the Association, the evening exercises were presided over by the Vice-President, Mrs. Chappell Cory.
