The resulting sheets were made into foundation with the Given press and fitted into the frames of two lives and on the 20th of July a colony of bees was put into one of them and on the 25th one was put into the other. The last was rather a weak colony and a little later superseded its queen so that it worked out only about one-half the foundation, while the other one made use of nearly all its foundation. At different times the colonies were examined for foul brood, but no sign of it was found till the 8th of October when nearly all brood being hatched out a thorough examination was made...
